PROFILE OF THE COLLEGE

Furkating College was established on 6th August 1981 representing the mass populated area of the Assam-Nagaland Border of Golaghat district, Assam. The people of Furkating and its adjoining area with great enthusiasm and cooperation resolved to establish an institution of Higher Education at Furkating town, the heart of a large area of 25 sq. miles. The College started functioning under the leadership of the Governing Body's founder President Late Mohen Baruah, founder Secretary Mr. Dugdha Dutta and founder Principal Late Firdus Ali Ahmed.

The College was started at Furkating High School from 22/06/1981 and later it was shifted to its own building in an area of about 9 Acres of land at the Tirual Grazing ground which was generously donated by the local people. The College is affiliated to the Dibrugarh University w.e.f. 28/07/1993.

After fourteen years of persistent effort and sacrifice of a group of well-wishers and dedicated teachers, the College obtained deficit grant-in-aid status in 1996 w.e.f. 11/01/1996 during the tenure of Governing Body President Late Nagen Neog, the then Cabinet Minister of the Government of Assam. The College was brought under provincialized system in 2005 as per provision of Assam College Employees Provincialisation Act 2005.

Presently, with the guidance of the present Principal, a group of dedicated and enthusiastic teachers, energetic ministerial staff, the College has been educating a number of pupils upto B.A. degree level and guiding the society with a clear vision. The College is determined to become a pioneer institution of higher education in the state of Assam.

A group of renowned educationists from outside the state as members of National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) assessed the College in September 2003 and awarded C++ Grade. Again, another group of educationists from different parts of India re-assessed the College in October 2010 with B Grade (point 2.63) & B++ Grade (2.76 point) in 2016. This is an inspiration for the College fraternity to go ahead in its quest for quality, perfection and meaningful education.

Admission:

Application form along with Prospectus for Higher Secondary is issued immediately after the announcement of the results of the H.S.L.C. Examinations. These can be collected from the college-office.

Admission Committee:

An Admission Committee is constituted by the college authority to conduct entire admission process following Government reservation policy for the reserved category students such as ST(P), ST(H), SC, OBC, MOBC etc. 2% Seats has been reserved for students having excellance in extra curricular activities.

Boys' & Girls' Hostel:

The college provides hostel facility to limited number of students on merit basis.

Identity Card:

The college authority issues Identity Cards for each student immediately after commencement of the classes.

Library:

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Scholarship and Award:

The college has sixteen digitally-equipped classrooms.

Students' Union:

Furkating College Students' Union is the general body of the students and the membership of it is compulsory. The members of the Union Body are annually elected by the students through election. The General Election to the Students' Union is conducted by an Election Committee constituted with teachers, as per rules and regulations of the Lyngdoh Committee Recommendations.

Excursion & Educational Tour:

Different teaching departments of the college arrange excursion/educational tour every year with financial assistance from the college authority.

Sports Facilities:

The College has one playground & an Indoor stadium with facilities of Table Tennis, Badminton as well as a Multi-gym. Moreover, The Rajib Gandhi Sports Complex with the facility of a football ground, Basket Ball court & an Indoor Stadium is adjacent to the college & is allowed to use for its students.
