It is to be noted that 21 questions were designed with Yes/No and other responses pattern and suggestion was sought in the last question. However, the overall responses were found to be positive and the percentage of suggestions extended by the students is also encouraging where they have put forward relevant suggestions.






Findings:

- 88% student respondents say that the existing vocational/self-financed courses have relevance whereas 12% say it has no relevance.
- 98% students are of the view that the courses are helpful in developing employability, on the other hand, only 2% respondents say no.
- Regarding the fee-structure of the courses 63% of student respondents rate High, 10% Low and 27% say it is bearable.
- § 58% respondents have extended suggestions for introducing new courses/programmes whereas 42% have not extended any suggestions regarding this matter.
- Regarding the teaching method of the teachers, 38% students have rated very good, 46% good and 16% as average.
- 60% of Student respondents say that the type of teaching method is beneficial whereas 40% say that it is not beneficial.
- Regarding the suggestions for the teachers to give them the best, 65% students have forwarded some suggestions, on the other hand, 35% have not extended any suggestion.
- 69% students have given suggestions to improve the academic performance of the institution whereas 31% have not forwarded any suggestion.
- 77% respondents say that Seminars/workshops and such practices are helpful to them and 23% of students say no.
- 79% of respondents are satisfied with the books and other facilities available in the library, whereas, 21% students are not satisfied.
- 46% students say that they are satisfied with the facilities available in the canteen, and 54% expresses their dissatisfaction.
- Regarding the facilities provided in the Girls' accommodation 83% respondents say good and 17% say not good enough.
- Regarding suggestions for other facilities 52% students have suggested, whereas, 48% have not suggested.
- 67% respondents say that the existing Co-curricular and extra-curricular activities are helpful whereas 33% negate the view.
- 69% students say that the Information and Career Guidance Cell is helpful and 31% say that it is not helpful.
- 69% respondents are of the view that Research Projects undertaken by various departments is beneficial and 31% opined that they are not beneficial.
- Regarding suggestions for other priority areas for research projects 56% students have suggested and 44% have not put forth any suggestion.
- About the college administration 87% students have rated as good, whereas, 13% average.

- 79% student respondents say that they get good support from the office staff and 31% say no.
- 79% respondents are satisfied with the performance of the faculty members but 31% students say that they are not satisfied.
- 67% of students have identified some of the areas where faculty members should emphasize whereas 33% students have remained neutral regarding this.
- 60% of student respondents have extended suggestions for overall development of the college whereas 40% of students remained neutral.

Suggestions:

- PG classes should be introduced.
- The college can introduce more self-financed courses for employability.
- More environment friendly courses should be introduced.
- Office staff should be more helpful and approachable.
- ICT in classroom teaching should be used regularly.
- Facilities in the college hostels should be improved.
- More research-oriented projects need to be taken up in the college.
- The college should take the initiative for accommodation of boys.

Chart 1: Question No.1






Chart 2: Question No. 2, 4-9




FINDINGS:

- 1. 62.5% Alumni are found employed in non-Governmental sector and 37.5% as self-employed.
- 2. 87.5% respondents say that they are satisfied with the infrastructural facilities provided by the college whereas 12.5% alumni respondents say they are not satisfied.
- 3. 75% Alumni respondents opine the college administration as excellent and 25% view as good.
- 4. 87.5% respondents say that they are satisfied with the service provided by the Office Staff and 12.5% say that they are not satisfied.
- 5. 75% Alumni expresses satisfaction with the quality of Teaching in the college whereas 25% as not satisfied.
- 6. 87.5% Alumni are satisfied with the Academic performance of the institution and 12.5% respondents say that they are not.
- 7. 100% Alumni respondents says that College maintains proper academic environment within the campus.
- 8. 75% say that they are happy with the introduction of Self-financing subjects in the college whereas 25% expresses unhappiness over it.

9. 25% Alumni extended their valuable suggestions towards making the institution an outstanding one, on the other hand, 75% respondents did not give any suggestion.

Few notable suggestions extended by the Alumni

- 1. Introduction of more courses and programmes
- 2. Besides providing valuable education, the teacher should also encourage the students in different perspectives so that they may be able to sustain their lives.
- 3. More congenial and student friendly atmosphere should be created in the college.













Findings:

- Reasons for admitting their child in this college 90% of parents say because of good academic atmosphere, 5% say because of Friendly nature of the teachers, 2% say because of Facilities provided to students and 3% say for in close proximity to my house.
- 90% parents say that their children are satisfied with college administration and 10% are not satisfied with.
- Opinion on fee structure of self-financed courses-68% Parents say expensive, 15% say reasonable and 17% says affordable.
- 82% Parent respondents say that they attend the Parent-Guardian meeting whereas 18% say fail to attend the meeting.
- The reasons they say are: 3% because of Intimation not received on time, 13% Insufficient time and 2% usually they don't attend meetings.
- 93% parents say that the college act upon the suggestions forwarded by the parents/guardians and 7% say don't.
- 80% respondents say they attend the parents meet arranged by the Parent-Teacher Association whereas 20% say don't attend.
- Opinion on the fee structure of the college: 10% parents say expensive, 81% say reasonable and 9% say affordable.
- 94% of the parents respondents say that they are satisfied with the teaching process on the other hand 6% say they are not.
- 96% parents view that the existing curriculum of the college is acceptable and 4% say not acceptable.
- 97% of parents say they are satisfied with the college administration only 3% say that they are not satisfied.
- Opinion of the Parents on the academic atmosphere of the college: 64% say as Good academic atmosphere, 2% Not up-to the mark, 12% Has scope to develop and 22% say Should have better results.
- Regarding suggestions on overall development of the college 25% have extended their valuable suggestions and 75% of the parent respondents did not extend any suggestions as such.

Suggestions:

- More faculties for Self-Financing Courses need to be employed
- College administration should be more approachable and friendly
- Parent-Teacher Meet should be held regularly to solve the various student related issues
- Fee structure should be made affordable
- Academic atmosphere of the college should have more scope for development of the students as a whole
- Support from the Office Staff should be enhanced.
