H.S. 1st Year	 Admission in the HS 1st Year for the session 2024-25 in Furkating College (Autonomous) will be based on percentage of marks obtained in the HSLC examination. Candidates have to submit an online application through the online admission portal DARPAN and the college will strictly follow the timeline of the portal. Four Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) B.A./B.Sc./B.Voc.	 Admission in the FYUGP for the session 2024-25 in Furkating College (Autonomous) will be given from two merit lists. First merit list will consist of 20% of total seats and it will be prepared based on percentage of marks obtained at NTA test for UG. The Second merit list will consist of 80% of total seats and will be prepared based on percentage of marks obtained in the HS final examination. Both merit lists will strictly follow reservation policy. Candidates have to submit an online application through the online admission portal SAMARTH and the college will strictly follow the SAMARTH timeline.
